Bishop Joseph Hanefeldt presided over the Mass and was joined by Bishop William Dendinger, Bishop-Elect James Golka and eight local priests.

Raegan Gellatly performing her original song "Ruby Avenue" which was dedicated to her classmates and warranted a standing ovation. Principal Jordan Engle addressed the class first. "You've had to say goodbye to someone you love. You've seen our school close for the first time in its history. You have come for an entire year covering half of your face to be around people you're supposed to relate to," he said. "None of that, at any point, has felt like it is going to be

OK." Engle applauded the graduating students for their resiliency and leadership in getting through the school year. "In the face of adversity," he said, "you guys rise up and face challenges with the most grace and humility, and grit and perseverance, that really I've ever seen in a class. God's plan is

bigger than ours, and sometimes our plans aren't going to work out, but God's plan is better than ours, and it is rooted in love," he said. "Because of that, whether we want to believe it or not, everything is, indeed, going to be OK."

Faculty speaker Cathy Howard reminisced on the class throughout

A BELOVED CRUSADER IS A BISHOP

On April 30, 2021, Pope Francis named Grand Island Central Catholic Alum Father James Golka as the third Bishop of Colorado Springs. "I am incredibly humbled and excited for the opportunity to join in the ministry and mission of the Catholic Church in the Diocese of Colorado Springs," said Bishop-elect Golka. "I ask for your prayers; please be assured of mine."



Bishop-elect Golka is the first priest of the Diocese of Grand Island, in the history of the diocese, to be named bishop. He became emotional during the press conference announcing the assignment, saying his heart is torn at the unexpected change in his ministry and moving away from Grand Island. "The tears are a sense of sadness, of being overwhelmed of the great magnitude of what's ahead of me, of gratitude for Jesus," he said.

When reflecting on his time at Central Catholic, Bishop-elect Golka said "I so much appreciate the sacrifice that my parents made in choosing Catholic education for all ten of their children. Their sacrifice of love has proven to be a blessing in all the lives of my family." He added, "I appreciate the education that I received at GICC. It prepared me well to succeed academically in college. More so, I appreciate the faith formation and the quality relationships which I received during my time at GICC. I grew in my love of Christ and our Catholic faith. I was also surrounded by faculty and friends who loved me and cared for me. I am grateful!"

Cathy Howard stated in her alumni story about Father Jim last year –

He wants us to be ambassadors of his love in the world," he said. "I would find it difficult to find better advice for you than our own Lord's words to us, to 'love one another as I have loved you.'" ●
