Changes to Financial Aid Process for 2024-2025

Grand Island Central Catholic families will be offered additional opportunities to gain financial aid for the 2024-2025 school year! With that comes a change to the procedure for applying for financial aid at GICC.

Parents must complete a two-step process moving forward, which we've simplified here.

STEP ONE:

Click on the Nebraska Opportunity Scholarships link to reach



the website for the State of Nebraska's new application for scholarships to private schools.

NEBRASKA OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIPS

Since Nebraska recently passed LB753 Opportunity Scholarship Act, this transformational law provides tuition assistance to eligible families through dollarfor-dollar tax credit contributions.

"Families with Crusaders entering grades K-6, as well as grade 9 (for the 2024-2025 school year) should sign up for updates and apply for these scholarships," Dr Jordan Engle said. "This can have a large impact on our GICC families because it widens the pool of funding available to their students."

The Opportunity Scholarships of Nebraska application window is set to open around February 15, with a deadline of April 15. Decisions will be made by July 1, 2024.

"Because of the importance of Crusader families applying for Opportunity Scholarships of Nebraska first and foremost, we have adjusted our timeline to accept applications for GICC Tuition Assistance and Scholarships," said Jolene Wojcik, Director of the Central Catholic Development Foundation.

Central Catholic has not only lengthened the window for internal applications, but also updated its application form.

STEP TWO:

After completing an application for the Opportunity Scholarships of Nebraska. GICC families will be able to apply for both





tuition assistance from the GICC Business Office and GICC scholarships from the Central Catholic Development Foundation. These options may reduce a family's tuition bill based on financial need and other criteria. Click the Financial Aid Application Form link to reach a printable form.

The application window for GICC's tuition assistance and scholarships is April 16 - June 14. Decisions will be made by August 1, 2024.

program, Tuition Savings While You Shop. This rebate program for current and future Crusader families reduces your tuition bill by the amount of rebates you accumulate. Rebates are applied to tuition balances twice per year. Click the link below.


