- Tomorrow-Wednesday, October 25, 2023—I am attending a FAFSA meeting in Kearney to gain information on filing the new, revised FAFSA. Students and parents will be provided information and instructions as soon as the FAFSA is released—forecast is end of December/January
- GICC graduating Seniors from the class of 2023 who are in the KHOP program presented information to current GICC Seniors who are interested in KHOP program at UNK. They offered tips and advice on applying, interviewing, and writing essays for the KHOP application process.
