

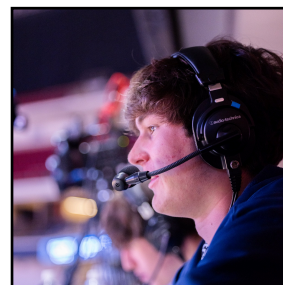
## VIDEO JOURNALISTS HONE SKILLS AT STATE
